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## **SCHOOL CHOICE ARIZONA**

School Choice Arizona was formed in 2006 primarily to implement the newly passed Corporate Tuition Tax Credit Law, but also to facilitate taking advantage of the Private School Tuition Tax Credit in special circumstances. Through these two avenues, our goal is to help families afford the education of their choice by providing scholarships to children attending qualified private schools in the state of Arizona.

## **IBE**

The Institute for Better Education (IBE) is a recognized 501 (c) (3) non-profit School Tuition Organization, or STO established in 1998 to accept tax credit donations to be used for private school scholarships.
